Thursday 1st January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Gal. 5:22-26

Thursday and Friday 8th and 9th January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Heb. 11:35-38

RAISING AN ALTAR FOR THE UNDERGROUND CHURCHES IN COMMUNIST NATIONS

A pastor by the name of Floresu was tortured with red hot iron pokers and with knives. He was beaten very badly. Then starving rats were driven into his cell through a large pipe. He could not sleep. BOKOHARAM AND INSECURITY IN NIGERIA

Nigeria is presently facing monumental security issues occasioned by terrorist activities of Boko Haram. From 2002 till date, this group has killed no fewer than 14,000 people, majorly Christians and burning hundreds of churches. In February 2014, 59 students (all boys) of Federal Government College Buru Yadi, Yobe state were shot to death in their hostels while asleep. In April 2014, over 200 girls from Government Girls Secondary Chibok, Borno state were kidnapped from their hostels. On June 15, 2014, Improvised Explosive Devices (IED's) were found in Winners Chapel, Owerri. Cry unto the Lord to arise over Nigeria. That for the sake of his name and glory, he should not allow his church to suffer reproach. Ask God to confound Boko Haram, their sponsors and sympathizers. Ask God to comfort and strengthen Northern Christians facing persecution. Ask God to provide for, protect and preserve his children. Pray for an out-pouring of the Holy Spirit upon them for a continued fellowship with God.

Saturday and Sunday 17th and 18th January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Psalm 24:7 – 10

PRAYING FOR THE UNREACHED PEOPLE

To fulfil the Great commission, we must from now begin to target those areas that are neglected in the cities, villages or in the rural areas, within or outside our nation. We should aim at areas of the greatest need just as Paul said that his ambition was to preach Christ where he has not been mentioned. The Lord Jesus Christ demonstrated this as recorded in Matthew 10:5-6 and in Luke 3:2 when he was sending the seventy to places where he was yet to reach. Pray that God will force doors which the enemy of the gospel had closed in communist nations, doors closed through the spirit of the bondwoman. Break the chains in the hands and legs of people. Remove every spiritual blindness through the word of God, utterance, unction, dream and vision. Ask the great deliverer -Jesus- to lose the captives of the mighty and set the captives free.

Monday and Tuesday 19th and 20th January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Esther 2:5-9

BURUNDI MISSION FIELD

A team of brethren in FMI went to Burundi mission field immediately after the AWMC of 2014. The team was led by Pastor Joseph Olunloyo. The team brought a good report based on the work on ground in Burundi through Bro and Mrs Adenipekun. Much was said on the glory and grace children orphanage home which has taken off. The orphanage home is to carve a future for the children who have lost their parents as a result of the civil war in Burundi. The Lord granted the brethren

open doors to have access to the president of Burundi. Apart from that, the team was granted permission to organize a prayer conference in January 2015 for the nations. Thank and praise the Lord for the lives of Brother and Mrs Kunle Adenipekun who are working silently to achieve great results. Pray that God will bring a complete turnaround in the lives of the youths and children through FMI missionary in Burundi. Ask the Lord to raise financial senders who will bankroll the bills of those children. Lord, increase your grace and strength on Pastor Kunle Adenipekun and the family to do more exploit for God in the nation. Ask the Lord to give them more revelations to improve their service to the people. Pray that God will open more doors to serve the Lord and provide labourers to do the work together.



Wednesday 21st January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Psalm 122:1-7

PRAY FOR ISRAEL

The word of God commands us to pray for the peace of Jerusalem until its righteousness goes forth as brightness and its salvation as a lamp that burns. Also, we are commanded to pray for Jerusalem with a promise that we shall prosper as we love her and those who curse her will be cursed by God. Ask God to forgive this nation for many of them have rejected Jesus Christ as Lord and Messiah. Bind the spirit of Judaism (the religion that believes in the Law of Moses rather than Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour) in the lives of the Jews. Pray to God to give peace to Jerusalem and entire Israel in the midst of Arabs and unbelieving nations that are continually antagonizing her. Ask God to raise more support for Israel against threats by Arab nations.

Thursday and Friday 22nd and 23rd January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Matthew 10:1

PRAY FOR THE DEATH OF EBOLA IN ECOWAS AND AFRICA.

Ebola is a disease that broke up in West Africa very early in 2014. The virus spread from Guinea, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Liberia and then to Nigeria. Many people have lost their lives to Ebola because the medical world and pharmacies had not been able to discover a cure for the virus. However, the doctors in Nigeria were able to combat the virus through the help of God. At the time of writing this bulletin,

there is no single victim of Ebola and all the people who were infected had been healed and discharged. However, it is yet to be curtailed in Sierra Leone and Liberia. There are over four thousand victims who are dead. Pray that Jesus the chief physician should intervene to heal the plague just like the case of Nigeria. Pray for strength and courage for the health workers in ECOWAS nation to treat victims of Ebola. Pray for W.H.O. and all medical practitioners who are working to discover the appropriate drugs to heal the victims of Ebola. Pray that the outbreak of Ebola will open doors to reach most of the victims by preaching the gospel of Jesus to them and see Jesus as a great healer.

Saturday and Sunday 24th and 25th January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Luke 9:1-6

TANZANIA MISSION FIELD

Bro Femi Ajibola with his family is FMI missionary in Tanzania. They are sustained by God's grace and with committed hands of local workers. The Lord has been opening doors of ministries in cities, towns and among people groups (with focus on the Wa Inaqws people). We have the following projects in order to fulfill the Mandate. Life-centre Tanzania is to Rehabilitate, Regenerate and reintegrate vulnerable youngsters like child prostitutes. This project is awaited by many helpless young lives in Tanzanian streets to kick start. But we are held back by the need for support to establish and facilitate it. Uzima Technical College, a skill acquisition college for poor, ordinary but willing youths in Tanzania. We got about 10 hectares of land for this project. With your prayers, support and God's favour, we hope to start building in 2015. Pray for open heaven and rain of supply on those life changing projects. Ask God for committed, God fearing workers /volunteers and for wisdom, capacity and discernment for us to effectively command great blessings and protection over our brethren, converts, prayer and financial supporters.

Monday and Tuesday 26th and 27th January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Eph 6:10-17

QUENCHING THE FIRE OF REBELLION

There is an increase in the activities religious terrorist groups around the world, especially Islamic fundamentalists – ISIS in Iraq, Taliban in Afghanistan and Pakistan, Al-queda, based in the middle East, Islamic brotherhood in Egypt, Alshabith in Somalia and Yemen, Boko Haram, terrorising the people of North Eastern part of Nigeria. Terrorism is a spirit of a rebellion. It is equal to witchcraft and witchcraft is not just a spirit of a religion. You need to summon the artillery of the kingdom of the Lord to subdue them. This is our objective and we strive to see the trio becoming part of every student we train. Fullstature College of the Bible and Missions has an open enrolment policy. Pray that the youths in FMC and other churches will take advantage of the open policy to be trained to minister in the House of the Lord. Ask the Lord to raise church Elders who will take responsibility to bear financial burden of many youths who are willing to attend the college but lack financial power. Bless the school faculty officers who teach in the school that God will remember their good works and grant them their heart desires. Pray for the school vice-principal and other members of the management for wisdom to run the school affairs. Lord, enlarge the coast of the school by providing acres of land to commence the building of the college's permanent site.

Friday and Saturday 30th and 31st January, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Ruth 1:8-22

MOMENT OF STORM IS FOR YOUR BLESSING

I quote Roman 8:28; "and we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them". Difficulties are opportunities in disguise, all endings are now beginnings. Lots of times, God's blessings come to us in form of difficulties, discouragement, pain or disappointment. Sunday and Monday 1st and 2nd February, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Eph 1:16-20

PRAY FOR MISSIONARIES, THEIR FAMILY AND THE MISSION FIELDS.

A Christian missionary is a person whose passion is to make the Lord Jesus known to the whole world. I believe that being a missionary in the truest sense of the word is taking the gospel where it has never been before or at least, to a different culture or language group. A true missionary is someone who will risk everything for the sake of the lost of this world. If brethren are to go, they need to be backed-up with a powerful intercessory altar. Pray according to John 16:13, the spirit of truth will guide them to carry out their vision and missions for their various fields. Pray for God to reveal the secret of the land to them and the methodology of how to fight the battle. Lord Jesus, lead the battle as the captain of the Lord of host and they would follow your command. Pray that God will give them the heart of the people and the land/field. Pray for Bro Yisa, the wife and children for good health, strength of the Holy Spirit and understanding to know what they ought to do during this forlong.

Sunday and Monday 8th and 9th February, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – Josh 6:10-16

Christians are both citizens and believers. As citizens, our response beyond praying for wisdom for our various governments is to hold political leaders accountable to what they have been elected to do which includes security for all. The church cannot leave the advocacy just to secular civil societies and human rights groups. Pray for the horrific killings of believers and minorities to cease. Pray for government leaders to have wisdom and cooperation in pursuing action against jihad groups. Pray for the faithful endurance of believers who suffer persecution. Pray for a special provision of God's grace and of his holy spirit for them. Pray for violent men to be moved from the kingdom of darkness to the kingdom of God.

Saturday and Sunday 14th and 15th February, 2015

Daily Bible Reading – 1 Thess 3:9-10

PRAY FOR MISSIONARIES AND UNREACHED PEOPLE

To evangelize the world with God's good news is not an option for the body of Christ. It is a mandate for every believer that had been redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ to work for the salvation of others. We need to set aside every personal ambition to face the business of the master. The command of God requires action and urgency. I believe the obedient Christians must respond by going, praying and giving. Pray for missionaries who are labouring on the fields that God should equip them with the whole armour to shield them from the satanic arrows and spears. In the face of persecution especially in the Middle East, ask the Lord to intervene and avert death sentence on them. THE SOMALI PEOPLE GROUP OF ETHIOPIA

The Somali people are found mainly in the Somalia Republic, the Somali region of Ethiopia and in northern Kenya. They comprise of a system of clan where each clan has its own tradition, chief and specific area which it occupies. The Somali people consist of 2 major family divisions – those that speak standard Somali Daarood, Dir. Hawiye and those that speak the Af-Maay which include the Rahawiin and the Digil. The Somali follow Sunmi Islam. Efforts at Christian mission have met with little success. There are only a few hundred Somali believers worldwide. Pray that the Lord would give the churches, Christian ministries and mission agencies love, wisdom and the right strategy to approach the Somali. Ask the Lord to open the hearts of the Somali for the gospel. Pray to God to raise a strong Somali church in places where the Somalis are found.

NIGER-DELTA MISSION FIELD

PRAYER AGAINST PIPELINE VANDALISM

It is a pity that almost 80% of Nigerian pipeline network has collapsed said the federal government. Respite seems not to be insight for traffic situation across the nation, especially on roads to the country ports, as the federal government some months disclosed that 80% of the country's 5120 kilometre pipeline network for petroleum products distribution has been vandalized. The managing director of PPMC said that currently, the Refineries are producing 5.1 litres of premium motor spirit, 3 million Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) and 2.1 litres of Dual Purpose Kerosene (DPK). He said the country is facing difficulties in distributing products through existing pipelines due to pipeline vandalism and rupture due to aging. Pray that the federal government would have a holistic solution to stop the vandalization of our pipelines.

WORSENING PRISON CONDITION

It is important to realize that prisons are meant to be correctional facilities to help reform those who engage in anti-social behaviours. But it is difficult to imagine the conditions in the prisons in Nigeria at this moment. The congestion in the nation's prisons is particularly attributable to the unduly large numbers of awaiting trial inmates. It is said that out of 56,785 inmates of Nigerian prisons, 38, 734 (68%) of them are awaiting trial inmates. The issue of overcrowding has to be addressed

by the federal government if they will not be experiencing an outbreak. We need to command the partnership of Prisoners Rehabilitation and Welfare Action (PRAWA) on NGO's who have been assisting to promote the welfare of Nigerian prisoners. Pray for over-hauling of Nigerian prisons, so that the prisoners will come out reform and refine.

PRAYER FOR MISSIONS WITH SPECIFIC ATTENTION TO NORTH KOREA


