### **Saturday and Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Aug 2015**

#### **Bible Reading – Zechariah 14:9**

#### **PREPARATION FOR THE AWMC 2015**

And the Lord shall be King over all the earth in that day shall there be one Lord and his name one. The Scripture above has further justifies that the whole world belongs to the Almighty God, who created all the beings, both living and non-living things, including man. **Daily Bible Reading – Job 31:24-28**

**PRAY AGAINST PIPELINE VANDALISM**

It appears only death could do the pipeline vandals in the country part with their illicit trade. Otherwise, all would have been quiet on the Arepo front given the number of casualties that had gone with illegal scooping of fuel which has become a pastime of the daredevil criminals for years. A video recording shows the suspected vandals scooping petrol which was gushing out of a ruptured pipe at Akimbo village and Arepo, Ogun State. The pipelines in Arepo are used to transport refined petroleum products from the Atlas cove Jetty in Lagos to the Western States and Kwara. The worst pipeline explosion in the country occurred on October 18, 1998 in Jesse Community in Ethiope-West local council of Delta State, over 1,000 people lost their lives. Pray for the government to look at the issue of pipeline vandalism and put stringent measure by training and equipping special security squad to protect the pipelines. Ask the National Assembly to ignite laws to punish the criminals involved and give adequate sentence or conviction. Pray that government at all levels will provide enabling environment to unemployed youths to create jobs and others to be gainfully employed.

**Wednesday and Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Sept 2015**

**Daily Bible Reading – Isaiah 9:2**

**PRAYER FOR UNREACH PEOPLE (Focus on the TUAREG in West Africa and North Africa)**

The Tuareg belong to a larger group of nomadic scattered in North and West Africa. The Tuareg men wear veils called tidjelmousts, the women do not wear veils. Though the Tuareg are virtually all sunni Muslims, they have a reputation among other Muslims for being lukewarm in their faith. They practice a passive form of Islam, infused with local superstitions and magic. Most do not even celebrate the most important Muslim fast of Ramadan. There are currently no known Tuareg Christians living in Nigeria. Prayer is the key to reaching these precious people with the gospel. Pray that missions organizations and churches will accept the challenge of adopting and reaching the Tuareg. Ask the Lord to send loving Christians from other parts of Africa to Nigeria to share the gospel with the Tuareg. Pray that God will reveal Himself to the Tuareg through dreams and visions. Ask the Lord to save key leaders among them (Tuareg) who will boldly declare the gospel. Pray for completion of Bible translation in this people group's primary language.

**Friday and Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Sept., 2015**

**Daily Bible Reading – Ps. 71:17-18**

**FMI YOUTHS**

'O God, You have taught me from my youth, and to this day. I declare your wondrous works. Now also when I am old and gray headed, O God, do not forsake me until I declare your strength to this generation, your power to everyone who is to come'. Ask the Lord to renew the strength of His servants and all the brethren that are working with them. Pray that this year 2015; their year of “double portion of anointing” will be true and evident to all CDMF stakeholders, partners, team members and church members.

Ask God for more financial supporters and pray for everyone who has supported this work in many different ways that God will continually reward their labours of love.

Read the summary of a troublesome rejected and wayward Fulani boy – Idi. He had an encounter with Jesus in 2012 even though he was a difficult boy who will not obey instructions. He has successfully undergone the 3 months Discipleship Missions Training course for 2013 session. In the last 2 years, Bro Zacheus Yisa had been discipling him. Idi has received the Holy Spirit baptism. By the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, Idi composed some songs and went boldly to a Christian Studio to record his songs. We are praying and waiting to see what God will use the Fulani boy and his songs to do not only among his people the Fulani's, but also among the believers nationwide. Thank God for touching the heart of Idi and saving him.

Pray that God will uphold him to the end, that Jesus would watch over him so that the wicked will not destroy him. Ask the Lord to release the spirit of Paul the apostle upon him, that he will be a mighty vessel in the hand of the Lord to bring light to the dark world of the Fulanis. Prophecy Ps. 91 over him and turn the counsel of Satan into foolishness over him.

Ask for financial support to back his songs ministry. Receive divine songs inspiration from the Lord for him.

**Tuesday and Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> & 21st Oct., 2015**

**Daily Bible Reading – Mark 16:15-18**

**NIGERIA MISSION FIELD**

Nigeria as a nation has so many unreached people groups in almost every part of the country. Presently, FMI is covering the Ijaw-Apoi community in Okitipupa area of Ondo state. Bro. Lamide King and the wife is the FMI missionary on the ground. Bro. Isidare Yao is working at Ibudo Sunday, Liberia and Voberal in Kwara/Niger state.

Bro Bala Joseph is at Tungaruwa. FMI is reaching out to the following unreached people groups – Bussawas, Barubas, Kemberis, Bokobarus, Fulanis, Ijaw Apoi and some migrated French speaking people from North Africa. The missionaries are reaching the people through community development, establishment of schools, Para-medical health centres, skill acquisition projects to get the youths engaged in skillful self-employed businesses/programmes, counseling and training for women. One of the major duties of the missionaries is to disciple their converts. Ask the Lord to shield the missionaries from the arrows of discouragement, confusion and witchcraft. Pray that no weapons fashion against them shall prosper. Pray that God should encourage and strength them as they go to execute God's mandate. Pray for the converts in the fields, that they should be ready to carry their cross and follow Jesus Christ. However, in spite of this threat, we still have to obey the commandment of the Lord Jesus. According to Matthew 10:16 – *Behold I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents and harmless as doves.* The ISIS, Boko Haram, Taliban etc are wolves, but they cannot stop the Lamb of God from liberating the people. Pray with Psalm 140:8 over the people, that henceforth, the Lord will not approve the desires of the wicked over the people. **Daily Bible Reading – Ezekiel 37:1-4**
